



About Tonight's World **Premier Performance**

When Jim Koch retired in 2009, a campaign was begun to commission a new piece of music in his honor. Thanks to donations from Jim's former students and parents, not only do we have a new piece, we have a new masterpiece!

Jim had often said that Martin Ellerby was among his very favorite composers. It was a thrill to have jim return to conduct the Brazoswood Symphonic Band in the 4th movement of *Paris Sketches* at the 2013 TMEA Honor Band concert. Shortly thereafter, we asked Dr. Ellerby if he would do us the honor of composing a new piece for band. Fortunately, he agreed!

We presented Dr. Ellerby with a challenging task: to compose a piece of music for someone that he had never met. After hearing our descriptions of Jim's personality traits and his musical tastes, Ellerby presented the concept of "A Man For All Seasons." The intervals for the melody are based on a cipher of the letters of Jim's name. These intervals happen to create a melody line that is fitting through all "seasons" of musical styles, including vivacious, lyrical, jazz-like, and humorous.

Words could never adequately express to Jim Koch the deeply heartfelt gratitude for the years of friendship, musicality, guidance, and mentorship. Victor Hugo said it best:

"Music expresses that which cannot be said and on which it is impossible to be silent."
